Dear Mr. McLaughlin,

I have been working with Juanito Aquino since May 2011. Juanito is the Study Coordinator on the INH-189-003 study (A Phase II, Randomized, Multi-center, Two Part Study of the Safety and Efficacy of Double-blind, Placebo-controlled INX-08189 in Adjunctive Treatment with Peginterferon alfa-2a (Pegasys[®]) and Ribavirin (Copegus[®]) in Study Part A, and Open-label INX-08189 in Adjunctive (Interferon Free) Treatment with Daclatasvir and/or Ribavirin (Copegus[®]) in Study Part B, in Chronically-infected HCV Genotype 2 and 3 Treatment-naïve Subjects) for which I am the CRO (SPRI) project manager.

Juanito is an absolute pleasure to work with. He is one of our "super star" study coordinators on this study. We can always count on him to have everything done exactly as expected. Juanito is very responsive to ad hoc requests for study related information. In addition, he does not hesitate to contact either myself or the site assigned monitor with questions when necessary. This open dialogue has helped us to establish a very good working relationship even though we've only met once at the Investigator Meeting last August.

Juanito's attention to detail cannot go unmentioned. He noticed and brought to our attention inconsistencies within the final versions of the protocol and electronic case report forms which had been missed during several rounds of review by multiple parties.

Juanito is also very patient and flexible. During Part A of this study, we've had to work together creatively when there were drug supply issues to do what was in the best interests of the subjects. Each time he handled gracefully having to tell subjects that the drug they needed was not on site and they would have to come back in a few days. More recently, for Part B of the study, dosing was suspended due to a safety issue and immediate subject follow up visits had to be arranged. Juanito coordinated all requests even though he was out sick and the other staff were communicating with him via text.

The site assigned monitor, Susan Taylor, cannot say enough good things about Juanito as well. She knows when she comes for a site visit subject charts, case report forms, and study files will be current and in order.

SPRI enjoys working with Juanito and the Anaheim Clinical Trials staff. We hope to be able to work with you again on future studies. You are definitely on our potential site list.
